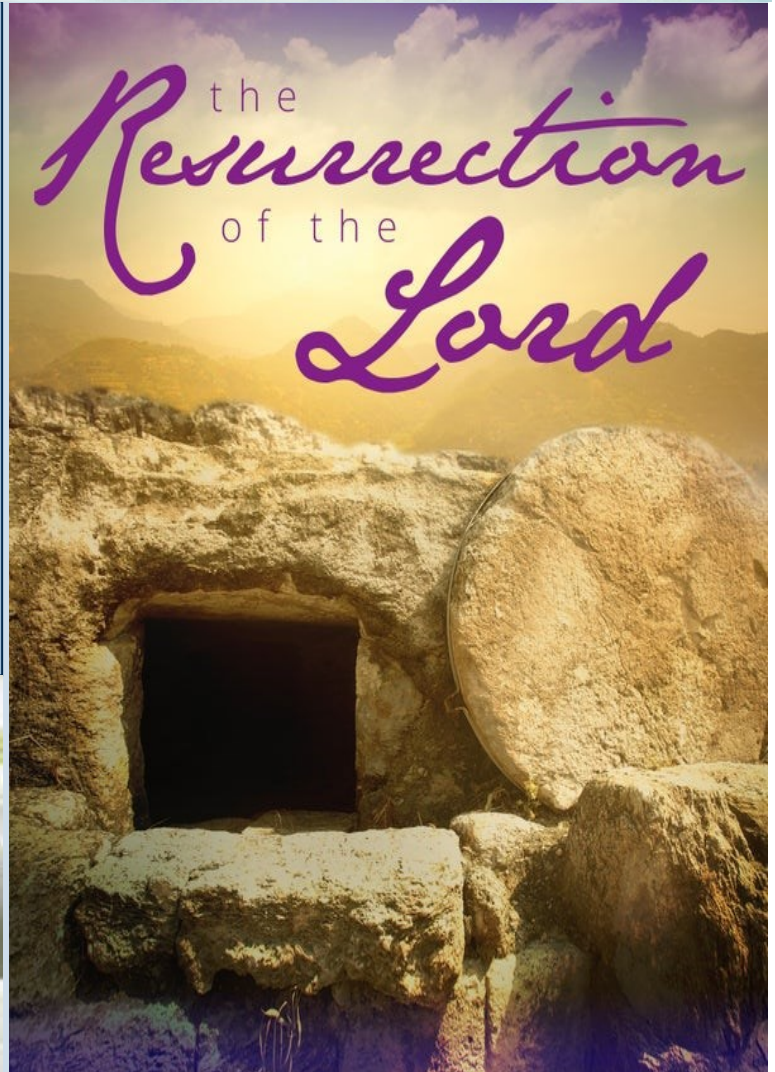

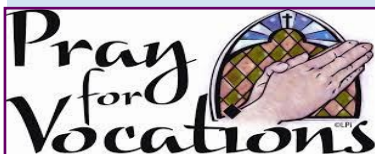

This Easter we recall the significance of the Resurrection. It is a fact of history and of our own experience. It was not just once upon a time; it is happening always, and we are part of it. Christ conquered death and rose again, and as we draw closer to Him, we rise above our own limitations, doubts, skepticisms, and fears, and embrace a new life.

Last Friday, we grieved for a man abandoned, naked, bleeding, and literally dying of a broken heart. Today we celebrate His rising from the dead! United to Him, there is hope. No matter how broken or lost we feel, there is always hope for renewal and redemption. Archbishop Fulton Sheen once eloquently stated, "Unless there is a Good Friday in your life, there can be no Easter Sunday." Our diocese's Patroness, St. Mary Magdalene, once given to every sin, possessed by seven demons as Scripture puts it, shows us now that even the worst sinner can find salvation through an encounter with the person Jesus Christ.

The Resurrection is a profound call also for the growth and vitality of Holy Family. We are called to reach beyond the beautiful grounds of the parish to invite and welcome our neighbors to encounter the risen Christ in Word and Sacrament. Just as the disciples were sent forth to proclaim the Good News of the Resurrection, so we too are called to witness hope and reconciliation in our own time and place.

May this Easter season be a time of spiritual renewal and growth for each of us, and may our parish continue to flourish as a beacon of light and love in our community.
