DID YOU KNOW? The Diocese of Salt Lake City requires all adults (<18) and youth minors (12 to 17) in contact (with or around) minors and vulnerable adults in our parishes and schools to complete trainings and background checks.

Recertification of these trainings and background checks are every 3 years for adults, and every year for youth minors. This is just one of the efforts undertaken by our diocese to protect our children and vulnerable adults. 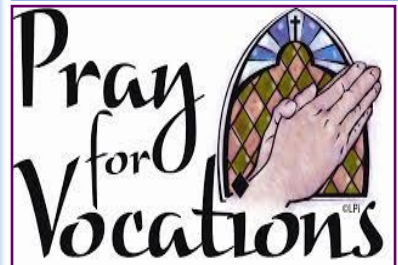

In today's digital age, scams are too common. Here are some key pointers to help you identify and avoid email and phone scams:

Be skeptical of phone calls and emails asking you for money or personal info, even you know

the person. In fact, they may not be the persons they claim to be.

Watch for urgent or immediate requests for personal information or some form of action. If you feel this may be an authentic request, get their information and verify it with someone you trust. If they deny you this information, it's probably a scam.

Beware of Threats or Pressure Tactics. Scammers use fear tactics to coerce victims. They may threaten legal action, claim your account has been compromised, or promise unrealistic rewards. Take a step back and assess the situation calmly before proceeding.

Be careful of precise payment instructions. While Father Joseph gladly accepts gift certificates (wink wink), he'll never urgently request you to send them to him, especially by email. Also beware if the claim is asked to be kept confidential.

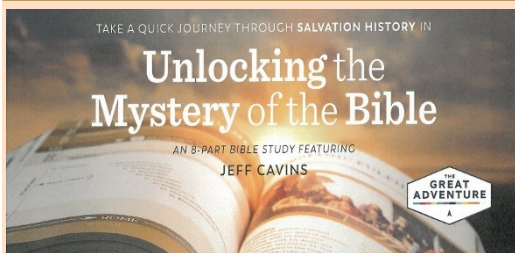
Trust Your Instincts: If something seems wrong, it probably is.
